Cotes du Roussillon, Calmel & Joseph, France, 2017 A blend of Grenache, Syrah and Carignan from 50 year-old vines, this wine is a deep purple-red in colour, almost black. The pronounced nose has hints of ripe red fruits, almost jammy while cherry, fig and dried plum dominate	-	39
